



Unit #3 – Studio Production – Camera Shot Assignment

TGJ3M – Communications Technology, Grade 11

Project Description:

- In this project students will use digital cameras to reproduce **photographic** examples of each of the **seven types of camera shots** used in studio production
- The **content** of the photograph is up to the student
- You must get **permission to leave the room**
- This is a **group project**, students will work in **groups of 2 or 3**
- The photos should be based around a **common theme**
- After you have taken the photos you will **arrange** them collage style in **Photoshop** to fit on an **8.5" x 11"** piece of paper
- Use **300 dpi** and allow for a **half inch border**
- Each photo must be **labelled** in the **Photoshop** layout with the type of **camera shot** that it represents

Materials:

You will be provided with the following materials:

- Adobe Photoshop CS5
- a digital camera
- batteries
- tripod (if needed)
- any other materials must be approved by the teacher and supplied by the student

Types of Camera Shots:

Review lesson 3-2 from the **website** and include one of each of the following shots:

1. Extreme Long Shot (XLS)
2. Long Shot (LS)
3. Medium Long Shot (MLS)
4. Medium Shot (MS)
5. Medium Close-Up (MCU)
6. Close-Up (CU)
7. Extreme Close-Up (XCU)

Steps:

Each group will:

1. **Select a theme** to base the photographs around.
2. **Take the 7 photos** representing each of the types of camera shots using the digital cameras provided (you may take extras and choose the best for your final layout).
3. **Transfer the photos** to your **X:\ drive**.
4. Start up a **new file in Photoshop**. The blank file should be **8.5" x 11"** (portrait) or **11" x 8.5"** (landscape) using **300 dpi**.
5. **Insert your photos** into the blank layout.
6. All photos should be the **same size** and be **appropriately labelled** with the **correct camera shot**.
7. **Save your PSD file** to the **X:\ drive**.
8. **Print off one hardcopy** per group on the color printer and hand in.
